Anne Louise Dunn, passed away in Lakewood Ranch, Florida on November 18th 2025. She was born in Lehigh, Pennsylvania on November 28th 1933. She moved with her parents to the Bronx, NY in 1939 where she grew up, married, and raised a family. She belonged to the choir at her local parish and loved to sing in her beautiful alto.

Anne became the first person in her family to graduate from college in 1955. She became a working mother in 1964, going on to a successful 40 year career as an executive at New York University. She moved to Greenwich Village in Manhattan when she became an empty nester and earned a Master's in Public Administration degree.

Anne was a beach lover and moved again to Aberdeen Township, New Jersey in the late 1980's. After retirement, she built two businesses: one offering document preparation services, and an antiques stall in the nearby Red Bank Antiques Mall. She enjoyed discovering treasures in thrift shops, spending time with her grandchildren, especially riding roller coasters, and traveling. She particularly enjoyed river cruises which took her to China, Scandinavia, and most of Europe.

Left to cherish her memory are her children Lorraine Gearing and Jean Shames; sister and traveling companion Susan Denogean; grandchildren Matthew Kinzle and his fiancée Alejandra Benavides, Amy Kinzle, and Alexander Shames and his fiancée Hilary Julianna; step-grandchildren Justin and Amy Shames; and great-grandchildren Justin and Jordan Kinzle. Anne is

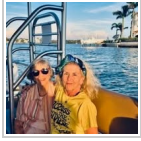
