Bernice I McPhee passed away on December 6 , 2022 at the Sarabella Assisted Living Facility in Sarasota, Florida at the age of 92.

Bernice was born in Arlington Massachusetts, the daughter of the late Lawrence and Della (Callahan) Devine. She resided in Winchester Mass before moving to Annapolis MD and most recently Sarasota, FL

She graduated from Winchester High School in 1947 and from Melrose Hospital School of Nursing as an RN in 1950. Upon graduation she worked at Mass Eye and Ear Hospital. She later received her bachelor (1970) and master's degrees in education (1972) from Boston University. In 1951 she graduated from the American Airlines flight attendant school and worked as a flight attendant. After returning to Massachusetts, Bernice worked as an operating room nurse at MGH and New England Baptist Hospital.

Bernice loved to travel. In 1981 she was a member of the first health education delegation from the US to visit and present in the People's Republic of China. She later helped organize and run national and international travels tours through the Senior Center in Winchester Massachusetts.

She is survived her daughter Della (McFatrige) Sweeney and her husband Joseph of Bradenton, FL. Her granddaughter Stephanie and her husband William Fink of Celebration FL, granddaughter Jaclyn and her husband Blake Sheperd of Marietta GA and two great grand daughters Eleanor Fink and Ava Sheperd.
