

## Charles Ellsworth Allen

February 19, 1945 - March 28, 2024

Charles Ellsworth Allen, 79, of Sarasota, Florida, passed away on March 28th, 2024. After a lengthy and impressive fight, Charlie's heart and kidneys could not keep up with his kind spirit, quick wit, and thoughtful nature.

Charlie was born on February 19th, 1945 to Ellsworth and Valjean Allen in Binghamton, NY. The family relocated to North Orwell, PA where Charlie attended elementary school and graduated from Northeast Bradford County High School. Charlie received his B.S. in Education from Mansfield University. Charlie loved teaching. He enjoyed his career as a public-school teacher for 35 years and that is where he met the love of his life, Patricia Cole Allen.

Teaching went beyond the classroom for Charlie. He and Patricia planned and opened a large childcare center. He obtained his M. Ed. from Northeastern University, and raised his children, Matthew and Katrina. Charlie managed to do all this while owning and managing an apartment house and serving on his local town's Board of Appeals.

Upon retiring, Charlie and his wife became snowbirds. They spent summers with family in New England, helping Pat's garden dreams come to reality.

Winters in Florida were always busy. Charlie volunteered as a tutor, participated in the Men's Group with the Unitarian Universalists of Sarasota, and attended theater and other events. He traveled the continental US extensively with his wife. He always enjoyed time spent with his grandchildren.

Charlie is survived by his wife, Patricia Cole Allen; his son, Matthew Allen and

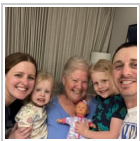
