David Spanos passed away in Sarasota, Florida on October 1st, 2025, He was born in Hamilton, Ontario Canada on April 20th 1978.

David received his Bachelor's Degree from McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario. When he made the move to the United States, he went on to earn his Master's Degree from Northeastern University in Boston, Massachusetts. He was a licensed CPA and worked in finance for the majority of his career. He also taught at the University of Miami, in Coral Gable, Florida.

David was a dedicated Jehovah's Witness and was baptized at the age of 19. More recently, David took his family to Greece, where he enjoyed seeking out the best "gyros" from morning till night. He also loved to play tennis with friends and especially his sons. David was very involved in cheering on his son's tennis team, and the coach even had to "keep him quiet" because he would shout so much encouragement to the team during the matches. David was everyone's cheerleader and brought so much positive energy to anyone he met.

Left to cherish David's bright memory are his devoted wife Daphne Spanos; sons Ariston Emmanuel Spanos, Leonidas Matthew Spanos; parents Evangelos and Anastasia Spanos; in-law parents Christos and Monica Georgiadis; brother Dan Spanos and his wife Melissa; brother-in-law Andrew Georgiadis; nieces and nephews Azlea, Kyra, Evangeline, Petros, Felipe; and his best friends Greg, Ricky, Robby, and Marco. 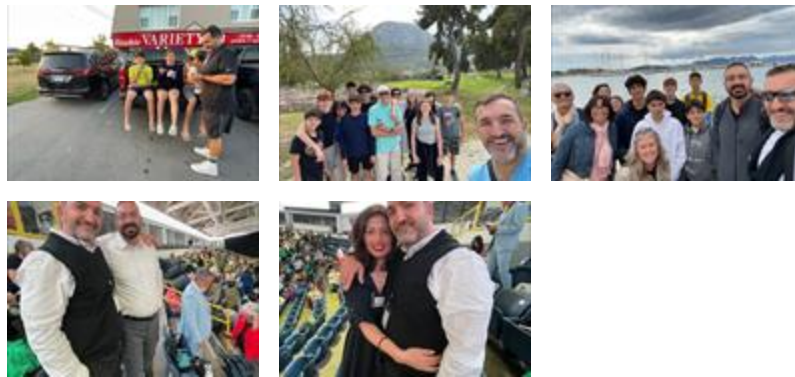
