Fannie “Fran” N. Schwartz, 90, passed to eternal life at home in Sarasota, Florida, Monday, April 3, 2023 after a short respiratory illness.


She was born December 20, 1932 to the late Joseph P. and Rachel (Nussbaum) Schwartz in Burr Oak, Michigan.

She is survived by her sisters, Katie Troyer, 101, of Muddy Pond, Tennessee; Margie Schwartz, 88, of Sarasota, Florida; brothers, Pete Schwartz, 84, and his wife Martha of Sarasota, Florida; and Noah Schwartz, 77, and his wife Mary Jane of Slanesville, West Virginia.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brothers, Joe, 98; Jacob, infant; Christian, 7; and Dan, 58.

Fannie never married but was a wonderful aunt to her nieces and nephews. 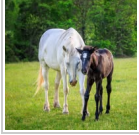
