



Frances Emma Frawley

July 14, 1924 - April 15, 2024

Frances Frawley (Micke) passed away on April 15th 2024 at the age of 99. She was born in Litchfield, Illinois on July 14th, 1924. After graduating from high school, Frances dedicated herself to being a homemaker for her family. In 1971, she moved to Florida where she spent the rest of her life.

During her time in Ft. Lauderdale, Frances volunteered delivering supplies to the migrants in Belle Glade and feeding Ft. Lauderdale's homeless. At the age of 79, she moved to Sarasota, graduated from Circus Sarasota's Clown Training Program, and continued with them as a volunteer clown. She found great joy in Hawaiian hula dancing with KAI-KU ONO MOKU, a local hula dance troupe. She loved having fun, bringing joy to others, traveling, and walking at least a mile a day.

Frances is preceded in death by her parents, James and Ora Britt, her husband, James, her sisters Kathryn Colleen Bahn and Jessie Buehling, and her son-in-law, Bob Moore.

Left to cherish her memory are her loving daughters Janis Frawley, Jacklyn Moore, and her beloved granddaughter Chrystal Reeck and her husband Jerry.
