



Frank Patrick O'Donnell

November 14, 1935 - March 5, 2023

Frank P. O'Donnell was born in Chicago of Irish immigrant parents, Daniel and Margaret (Gallagher). Mr. O'Donnell was very proud of his heritage.

He was a graduate of De Paul University in 1958 with a major in psychology. He obtained his Masters of Hospital Administration from Baylor University while on active military duty.

He was a career soldier and a dedicated and patriotic American. He was a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and was also a graduate of the U.S. Army War College Class of 1978. He was recognized for outstanding performance of duty as Senior Medical Service Staff Officer by the Joint Chiefs of Staff from July 1978-June 1980. He retired from the Army as a Lieutenant Colonel after 22 years of service in 1980. After serving in the Army Mr. O'Donnell was the Vice President of Clinical Services at Carney Hospital in Boston, MA where he served for 17 years.

In 1996 he moved to Sarasota, Florida to relax in the sun and pursue his love of golf. He liked to teach golf and was a member of the United States Golf Teacher Federation. Frank also enjoyed football and dancing.

Left to cherish his memory are his wife, Hazel; brother, Reverend Hugh O'Donnell C.M., daughter, Catherine Moore (Daniel); son, Thomas O'Donnell (Erin) and daughter Anne Lyons (Michael); step children, Steven and Kimberly Gruenberg; 7 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Frank was predeceased by his first wife Mary; brothers John and Patrick; and step-son John.
