February 19, 1955 - June 29, 2023

Dr. Greg Wrigley's, 68, journey on earth may have ended on June 29, 2023, but his impact will continue to resonate in our hearts forever. He was born February 19, 1955 in San Diego, California to the late George Robert and Betty Elizabeth (Fromm) Wrigley.

Greg's life was committed to ministry. He earned a Bachelor's degree in history from Shorter University, a Master's in ministry from Southwestern Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas, and a Doctorate of Ministry from the Theological Seminary in New Orleans.

Known as "Dr. G," Greg served his whole adult life as a minister. He preached at several churches throughout Georgia and North Florida. He took a position as the Director of Missions for the Black Creek Baptist Association. He then served as the Associate Executive Director for the West Virginia Convention of Southern Baptists.

Greg was a true outdoorsman, enjoying hunting, fishing, gardening, and reveling in sports, especially for NFL football and making brackets for March Madness. At the time of his passing, he was a member of Woodland Community Church.

medical care team, and therapists who helped Claudia assist with his daily needs, giving him the ability to remain at home during his illness.

In addition to his parents, Greg was predeceased by his brother, Kevin Wrigley.
