James E. Mack, 89, passed away June 27, 2024. He was born September 18, 1934 in South Bend,

Indiana to the late John Grant and Kathleen (Martin) Mack.

James earned his Bachelor's Degree from the University of Notre Dame and then served two years in the

United States Navy. He was the President and CEO of Tyler Refrigeration Corporation. He and his wife

Jane began splitting their time between Sarasota and Michigan City, Indiana 40 years ago. In 1990, they

purchased their home on Longboat Key and moved down permanently 20 years ago. They were

members of St. Mary Star of the Sea Catholic Church, the Sara Bay Country Club, and the Long Beach

Country Club and Notre Dame Catholic Church in Michigan City. James was the ultimate family man. He

loved his family along with golfing and his Notre Dame and Chicago sports teams.
