Jason Mathew Cucchi, 46, of Lutz, lost his battle with depression on September 23, 2022. Jason was born May 16, 1976, in Sarasota and spent most of his life in Florida. He graduated from Venice High School and continued to the University of Central Florida (go Knights!), where he was a devoted member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon (SAE) and graduated with a degree in Criminal Justice. He went on to spend his entire career in sales, which he both enjoyed and excelled at. He took joy in volunteering, especially with Tampa Bay Little League and Feeding Tampa Bay.
