



## John Raymond Bolotin

November 6, 1939 - May 8, 2025

John Raymond Bolotin, 85, passed away peacefully on May 8, 2025, at home, after a courageous nine-year battle with cancer.

Born on November 6, 1939, in North Canaan, Connecticut, John was the beloved child of the late John George and Anna Cergayovna (Olenik) Bolotin. From an early age, John demonstrated a remarkable aptitude for problem-solving and craftsmanship—skills that would serve him well throughout a long and accomplished life.
