Joseph Edward Williams, 84, passed away March 1, 2024. He was born April 21, 1939 in Brooklyn, New York to the late Joseph Alloysius and Madeline Ann (Swayne) Williams.

Joseph was raised as a Catholic and was a graduate of Suffolk Community College.

He proudly served in the US Marine Corps. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) as well as the Marine Corp League.
