



Joseph Kenneth Zawasky

August 25, 1944 - June 14, 2024

Joseph Kenneth Zawasky (“Joe”), 79, peacefully passed away in Sarasota, Florida on June 14, 2024. He was born in Lorain, Ohio to the late Joseph and Helen Zawasky. He moved to Sarasota in 1991 and remained there as a resident until his passing.

Joe graduated from high school at Borromeo Seminary in Wickliffe, Ohio. He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Education from Kent State University, Ohio in 1967. After college, Joe moved to Turlock, California where he taught high school Spanish. In 1971, he joined the United States Marine Corps and proudly served for 20 years as a Supply Officer. During his career, he served multiple tours overseas in Okinawa, Japan, as well as in North and South Carolina. Joe relocated to Florida in 1991, following his retirement from the Marine Corps as a Major. After the Marine Corps, Joe was a Probation Officer for the State of Florida.

Joe loved being outdoors as well as exercising and he ran the Marine Corps Marathon twice. He was an avid runner, an accordion player and reader of Tom Clancy novels. When Joe could no longer run, he would walk almost every day. Joe enjoyed listening to polka music. Joe's warmth, enthusiasm, energy and love for his family will forever be missed.

Left to cherish his memory are his former wife, Tomiko Zawasky; children

Mary Handy and her husband David, Michelle Voelpel and her husband Jason, and Joseph Zawasky; sister Jeanette Holp and her husband Michael; grandchildren Jacob and Avery Handy; as well as many nieces and nephews.

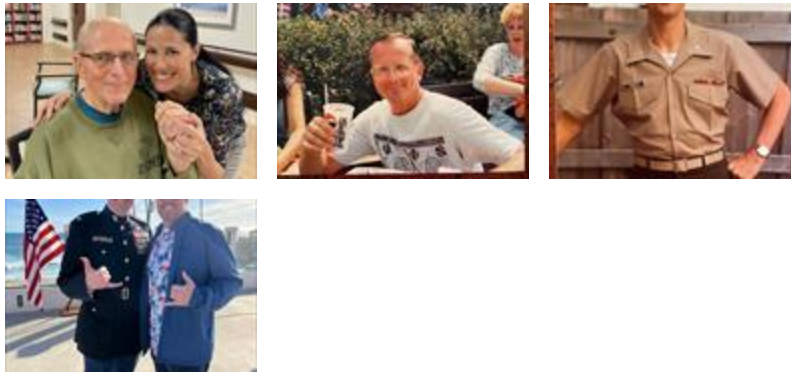
