Marc Lawrence Hoogstraten, 62, passed away unexpectedly on July 14, 2021 in Sarasota, Florida. Born January 23, 1959 in Passaic, New Jersey to Diana (Zanette) Hoogstraten and the late Col. Richard B. 'Dutch' Hoogstraten, U.S. Army ret.
