Neil Nathaniel Naphtali, 71, passed away May 26, 2026 in Bradenton, Florida. He was born May 16, 1955 to the late Harold and Seeta Naphtali in Piparo, Trinidad and Tobago. Neil came to Manatee County area in January of 2021 from Marietta, Georgia.

Neil was a Methodist and attended church in Parrish, Florida. He met his future wife, Hema, in Toronto, Canada. For his career, Neil was a mechanical engineer for Anheuser-Busch for 30 years. In his free time, he was a “car guy,” loved music and art, traveling especially Caribbean cruises, and cricket.
