Patricia Ann (Larson) Gerdts, age 83, passed away on the evening of May 24, 2024 in Sarasota, Florida after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Patricia "Pat" was born on October 5, 1940 in a small town in Nebraska to parents Roy and Iva Larson. She graduated from Central City High School in 1958. While there, she was a cheerleader, drum majorette with the marching band, gave baton twirling lessons, and was honored as Queen of Job's Daughters. She remained in contact with her friends from Central City throughout her entire life.

After high school, Patricia attended the Lincoln School of Commerce in Lincoln, Nebraska. Post-graduation, she worked for radio station KFOR before marrying former husband Richard "Dick" Gerdts at First Presbyterian Church in Lincoln. She married her second husband, Dorian Waterson, in 2009 and they split their time between Florida, England and traveling until Dorian passed away in 2010. Pat was later blessed to have time and companionship with Carl Rosetti, who lived near her in The Villages, until Carl passed away in 2022.
