



Ronald "Ron" Reeves Williams

Ronald (Ron) Reeves Williams, 84, went to his heavenly home on March 20th, 2024. He was born July 25th, 1939 in Miami, Florida to the late John and Mabel (Drake) Williams.

As a young boy growing up in Miami, Ron enjoyed go-kart racing and water skiing in Biscayne Bay. It was in Miami that he met the love of his life, Miriam. They came to Sarasota in 1966 from Miami where they lovingly raised their two daughters, Dawn Leigh and Rhonda Ann. Ron served at FPL (Florida Power & Light) for over 35 years where he retired as the Load and Voltage Supervisor in the Trouble Office. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and the Carrie B. Fish Masonic Lodge. Ron was a master woodworker restoring and creating treasured heirloom furniture; he hand-built the custom rocking cradle that his granddaughters used during their infant years and will continue to be treasured by his great grandson soon to be born. The family spent their years boating and fishing in the Gulf of Mexico and camping in the mountains of Western North Carolina. Ron spent his retirement years riding his beloved Harley Davidson motorcycles. Ron's love of Harley Davidson motorcycles came naturally—his father rode a Harley as a police officer in Miami during World War II.

Left to cherish his memory are his wife of 63 years, Miriam; daughters Dawn Leigh Allen and her husband Scott; and Rhonda Ann Kapusta and her
