Sheila Sanders Vaughan went to be with the Lord on December 3, 2021 in Sarasota, Florida. She was surrounded by her family in her home.

Sheila was born on September 21, 1931 in Chicago, Illinois to Henry and Dorothy Sanders. She graduated from Northwestern University in 1952 with a Bachelor of Science in Education. She taught second grade at Greeley Elementary in Winnetka, Illinois. While Sheila was teaching, she met Richard "Dick" Hugh Vaughan, and they got married on December 18, 1954. They lived in Glenview, Illinois; Needham, Massachusetts; Bethesda, Maryland; and Greenwich, Connecticut before settling with their four children in Sarasota, Florida in 1970 where they started their own audio and video tape distribution company, Vaughan Associates. Sheila and Dick worked side by side for 31 years until Dick passed away in 2001.
