Treva Dockery Robinson passed away December 2, 2024 in Sarasota, Florida at the age of 92. She was born October 23, 1932 in Ethridge, Tennessee.

Treva and her young family of five moved to Sarasota in 1965. She was a proud homemaker and enjoyed raising her 3 children. She volunteered for school functions and was an active member of the PTA. She also was a Red Cross volunteer at Sarasota Memorial Hospital for many years while the children were in school.

She joined First United Methodist Church soon after settling in Sarasota. She began volunteering right away and she taught a pre-school class on Sundays.
